### **Frequently Asked Questions**

### 1. Who should participate in the Procurement Executive Transition Forum?

The Procurement Executive Transition Forum is designed for procurement leaders who are in their first 12 months of their role. Transitioning into an executive role in procurement require leaders to quickly understand the organization, create relationships with executives across the business and start deliver impact. The program is designed to help leaders shape their transformation journey and get off on a good start. It will also allow time for leaders to ask and reflect on important questions on mind. The program is also relevant for procurement leaders who have been in their role and now are shaping the plan for the next horizon of their transformation journey.

### 2. What do I have to prepare to participate in the Procurement Executive Transition Forum?

The forum is built on peer-to-peer discussions facilitated by our senior advisors with extensive CPO experience. To facilitate the discussion in the best way for the participants, it is important that the facilitators fully understand your situation and considerations. We will therefore run 1-on-1 discussion(s) with yourself before the session to understand your starting point and expectations.

### 3. How are you handling confidentiality?

All information shared and discussed during the Procurement Executive Transition Forum is confidential and participants are strongly advised to keep the information between the participants in the session only. The Procurement Executive Transition Forum will not host industry competitors in same cohort to ensure confidentiality.

### 4. How many participants will join and what will the setting be?

We invite a selected group of 5-10 procurement leaders to this private setting. The Procurement Executive Transition Forum will be focused on discussions and peer-to-peer coaching under the facilitation of our senior advisors. There is an agenda outlined which is designed to allow for discussions on topics most relevant to participants.

#### 5. If I have to cancel the participation, what should I do?

Invited participants can be part of the Procurement Executive Transition Forum free of charge. We fully understand that other priorities can appear. The forum is primarily focused on knowledge sharing among participants and a great efforts are invested in preparing for the discussions.
